

PGICA CAR CLUB BYLAWS

Article 1. Name and Purpose

Section 1: The name of the organization is the PGICA CAR CLUB, an automobile club operating within the authority and sanction of the Punta Gorda Isles Civic Association (PGICA).

Section 2: The purpose of the club is to create camaraderie among PGICA enthusiasts through the fun and enjoyment of owning and operating special and/or antique automobiles. The Club will sponsor road trips, automobile maintenance/safety education, displays/shows and related social activities.

Article 2. —Membership and Dues

Section 1: Regular members must be current adult members of the PGICA who own a motor vehicle; (2) are legally licensed to operate a motor vehicle on the roads in the USA; (3) must agree to the purpose of the club and adhere to these bylaws; and (4) have paid the requisite fees and dues.

Section 2: Regular membership is limited to 200 people so that members may develop camaraderie inherent in a small group.

Section 3: Membership dues, fees and special assessments shall be established from time to time by the Executive Board, voted upon at general membership meeting and published in the Operating Policies and the Club newsletter and/or website.

Article 3: Meetings

Section 1: General membership meeting will be held each month unless otherwise notified.

Article 4: Organization

Section I: The activities of the club shall be managed by an Executive Board of Directors numbering **nine** and consisting **five** principal officers which are **(President, Vice President, Secretary, Treasurer and Past President)**. Additional directors shall be **(Membership, Cruise & Social, Public Relations, and Safety and Education)**. All officers will be elected or appointed for terms of one year.

Article 5: Committees

Section I: To operate the club, there will be a number of standing committees. These committees will be appointed as needed. Each committee will report to the appropriate club officer.

Article 6: Rules of Order

Section 1: Robert's Rules of Order, latest revision, shall govern the conduct of all meetings of the General Membership and the Executive Board. The presiding official may appoint a parliamentarian for interpretation or clarification of any rule, should the need arise.

Article 7: These By-laws may be amended by a two-thirds majority of the membership attending any general meeting or a special meeting called for that purpose. The proposed amendment(s) shall be provided to the membership at a meeting preceding the actual meeting at which the proposed amendment(s) are to be voted upon.

Article 8: Dissolution:

Section 1: In the event of dissolution of the "PGI CAR CLUB" the remaining net assets of the Club shall be transferred to the Punta Gorda Isles Civic Association account.
